PARK RULES FOR TOURISTS

Welcome to Wangi Point Lakeside Holiday Park. To ensure the comfort and safety of all our guests, we ask that you take the time to familiarise yourself with our Park Rules and Regulations. Your co-operation is appreciated.

Persons proposing to stay for a longer period must notify their intention to do so at the office.

OFFICE HOURS: 8.30AM – 6.00PM.

- 1. ALL CARAVANS & CAMPER TRAILERS** are required to have the drawbar facing the road and to be placed upon the site so that it is a minimum of 1 metre off the road and 2.5 metres from the unit on the next site.
- 2. ALL PAYMENTS** must be made at office on arrival. You will NOT be admitted to the Park until your required fees are paid. Fees are non-refundable.
- 3. ALL SITES** must be maintained in a clean and tidy condition and vacated clean and tidy. Rubbish, waste material, and debris are NOT permitted to remain in or around a site.
- 4. BIKES** roller blades, scooters and all wheeled toys must be used on roadways only and NOT on pathways or around amenities blocks. The management of the Park is not responsible for any accident or injury caused whilst using such toys in the Park.
All activities of this nature must cease at sundown. Normal road rules apply and helmets MUST be worn.
- 5. CARAVAN & TENT SITES** maximum of 6 people per site.
- 6. DAMAGE** to Parks property will NOT be tolerated including local flora and fauna.
- 7. FIRES** are permissible within the designated fire pits from Easter to October long weekend ONLY unless a Total Fire Ban is in force. Lighting of open flame BBQs, Braziers etc are NOT permitted within the Park.
- 8. FISH CLEANING** is NOT permitted within the Park. Cleaning facilities are available on the foreshore.
- 9. GARBAGE** must be wrapped in bags and placed in the garbage bins provided.
- 10. GENERATORS** are NOT permitted in The Park.
- 11. RECYCLING** bins are available and we encourage recycling to minimise the impact on the environment.
- 12. HAND BASINS** must NOT be used for the washing of clothes, crockery or cooking utensils.
- 13. LAUNDRY TUBS** are to for the washing of clothes ONLY and must be left clean after use.
- 14. MOTOR VEHICLES & BOATS** only one car is permitted per site and must NOT be parked on roadways or other sites within the Park, boats and additional vehicles may be permitted but only by arrangement with the Manager. Please do NOT park on caravan slabs.
- 15. NOISE** drunkenness and offensive behaviour will not be tolerated under any circumstances. Noise likely to disturb neighbours is NOT permitted and all noise is to cease by 10.00pm sharp. Patrons are responsible for the behaviour of guests.
- 16. PETS** are NOT permitted on the Park.
- 17. SHOWERS & TOILETS** an ADULT MUST accompany Children under 10yrs.
- 18. SITES** and accommodation MUST be vacated by 10.00am on departure date.
- 19. SPEED LIMITS** for the safety of all guests please keep speed limit to 10km/h at all times.
- 20. SMOKING** is NOT permitted inside all buildings, within 4 metres of public buildings and within 10 metres of playgrounds.
- 21. TRENCHES** must NOT be dug around tents or annexes.
- 22. NO RESPONSIBILITY** is taken by Management or Council for personal injury, damage, or loss of property. Guests are responsible to secure their belongings at all times.
- 23. NO BULK ALCOHOL** (temprites kegs etc) permitted.

BREACH OF RULES persons failing to observe, or who breach any of the Parks Rules and Regulations will be personally liable, directed from the park and may face a permanent ban or prosecution.
